## Occasional Sale Exemption

(Idaho Code section 63-3622K and Idaho Sales and Use Tax Administrative Rule 99)

You can claim an exemption from sales or use tax for an office trailer or transport trailer if you bought the trailer from an occasional seller. An occasional seller is someone who hasn't made more than one other sale of tangible personal property in the last 12 months, isn't a dealer, and doesn't have an Idaho seller's permit.

Use this form to claim the occasional sale exemption when titling or registering your office trailer or transport trailer.
