

## Basic Queries of ArcMap

This course is designed to help mapping staff become proficient creating basic queries and code within ArcMap 9.3. This class is for **nonprogrammers** who want to explore methods to improve their work products and processes. Students will learn about the many places that queries and code can be entered in ArcMap to enhance maps, manipulate labeling, edit or create attribute data, and perform analysis. If time permits we will introduce the use of Model Builder. Topics include:

- Formatting tags
- Select by attribute
- Label expressions
- Definition queries and field calculator
- Defining label classes
- GIS linkage
