

## **COUNTY COMMISSIONER TRAINING**

The Tax Commission will conduct the biennial training as required by law I.C. 63-105A (17). The training will cover the 2014 Board of Equalization manual adopted by the Idaho Association of Counties Board of Directors. This will be a one-day session and will include a brief review of the appraisal process and case studies on valuation appeals. Also, this year there will be a brief discussion on Exemptions.

This training will be conducted by Steve Fiscus, Division Administrator and Matt Virgil, Section Manager for the Property Tax Division of the Idaho State Tax Commission. All commissioners as well as any other elected officials are invited to attend. This is not intended as training for the Assessor's appraisal staff.
