DESCRIPTION: This course is an introduction to cadastral mapping. It is one of the requirements to become a Certified Cadastral Specialist. General topics include: Idaho mapping laws, manual drafting techniques, conveyances, deed processing, PLSS, metes and bounds, state plane coordinate system, and Idaho parcel numbering systems. It also includes an introduction to surveys used in the Assessor's office such as mineral, homestead, route, hydrographic and railroad surveys.
