

Building Spreadsheets to Analyze Data

This “hands-on” seminar will provide instruction on creating efficient spreadsheets for data analysis. It will include examples for time adjustment analysis, land analysis, and speculative value analysis. The basis of this seminar is to stress a “form follows function” approach to spreadsheet design and development. The course will cover data and database requirements, analysis steps, conclusions, and summary information. A simple AS400 query on data will be demonstrated, saving the results to a file, and then opening the file in Excel. We will also query data with Crystal Reports and ProVal, and open the files in Excel.
