A Petition having been presented to the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners pursuant to Title 33, Chapter 27, of the Idaho Code on the consolidation of the Post Falls City Library with the Kootenai – Shoshone Library District and said Petition having been canvassed and Public Hearing held November 10, 2009 on said consolidation and the results of said Petition and Hearing by the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners, all according to law.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Post Falls City Library and the Kootenai – Shoshone Library District be consolidated effective October 1, 2010, with Kootenai County as the Home County, and shall be known as the Consolidated Library District whose boundaries shall be as follows:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the west boundary line of Shoshone County with the north boundary line of Section 22, Township 47 North, Range 1 East, Boise Meridian, being the POINT OF BEGINNING;

Thence south along the western boundary of Shoshone County to the north boundary line of Section 15, Township 51 North, Range 1 East;







LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF THE CONSOLIDATED FREE LIBRARY DISTRICT

Thence east along said Township line between Townships fifty-three (53) and fifty-four (54) north, to the northeast corner of Township fifty-three (53) north, Range three (3) west; thence north on the range line between Sections thirty-six (36) and thirty-one (31) to the northeast corner of Section thirty-six (36), Township fifty-four (54) north, Range three (3) west; thence east six (6) miles, to the northeast corner of Section thirty-six (36), Township fifty-four (54) north, Range two (2) west; thence south along the range line between Ranges one (1) and two (2) west, to the southwest corner of Township fifty-three (53) north, Range one (1) west; thence east on the Township line between Townships fifty-two (52) and fifty-three (53) north, to the intersection of the said line with the western boundary of Shoshone county (1909, p. 318);

Thence south along the western boundary of Shoshone County to the north boundary line of Section 15, Township 51 North, Range 1 East;

thence due east to the northeast corner of Section 13, Township 51 North, Range 2 East; thence due south 4 (four) miles; thence due east 4 (four) miles; thence due south 3 (three) miles; thence due west 1 (one) mile; thence due south 6 (six) miles; thence due west 6 1/2 (six and one-half) miles; thence due south 6 (six) miles; thence due east 2 1/2 (two and one-half) miles; thence due south 6 (six) miles; thence due west to the western boundary line of Shoshone County; thence due north along the western boundary line of Shoshone County to the intersection with the north boundary line of Section 22, Township 47 North, Range 1 East, Boise Meridian, being the POINT OF BEGINNING.

Intergovernmental Agreement Regarding Intent, Contingent Upon Election Results

Whereas, the City of Post Falls (City) is a municipal corporation of the State of Idaho that owns and operates a municipal library to serve the residents of the Post Falls community, and

Whereas, the Kootenai-Shoshone Area Library District (District) is a quasi-municipal corporation of the State of Idaho that owns and operates public library facilities throughout Kootenai County, Idaho, and western Shoshone County, Idaho, and

Whereas, both the City and District have engaged in cooperative undertakings concerning provision of library and information services over the course of many years, and

Whereas, the Library Board of the City of Post Falls has expressed its support for consideration of merging the City's library services with those of the District, and

Whereas, the City of Post Falls is aware that a petition is in circulation in support of an election to determine whether the library services of the City and the District should be combined and unified under the ultimate direction of the District, and

Whereas, it is the desire of the parties to express their intent concerning interests of the City and regarding the disposition of assets of the City in the event that voters should authorize inclusion of the City within the boundaries of the District,

Now, therefore, be it agreed, as an expression of intent, that if the question of inclusion of the City of Post Falls into the Kootenai-Shoshone Area Library District is submitted to the voters of Post Falls and a favorable vote results, the following actions and policies will be carried out by the City and District, respectively:

I. Actions that the City will do:

- A. Will certify that a minimum of \$780,000 of the 2010 Post Falls Library operations and maintenance budget is derived from a tax on real property within the current corporate limits of the City of Post Falls. Upon merger, the District would be entitled to receive this tax revenue to operate the library.
- B. Will lease the current Post Falls Library site to the District for use as a public library facility, as is, after the recent repairs and refurbishment including the HVAC system. The lease rate will be nominal, not to exceed \$500 dollars per annum.
- C. Will maintain liability insurance on the premises in amounts sufficient to meet the liability obligations established by Idaho law.
- D. Will transfer all contents of the Post Falls Library including all books, media, magazines, furniture, computers, rack systems, security systems, and automated checkout stations (excepting Amazon Kindle units) to the Kootenai-Shoshone Area Library District no later than 1 October 2010 after a successful vote of the electorate of Post Falls to join the District.
- E. Will transfer the library structure and site improvements to the Kootenai-Shoshone Area Library District once the City's General Obligation Bond indebtedness on the facility has been paid. The last scheduled payment of the Library debt is expected to occur prior to 1 March 2013. Until authority to transfer can be exercised, City will allow District full use of the building and grounds of the current City library as part of the lease of the grounds anticipated hereby.
- F. Will transfer the following LGIP Investment accounts to the District for use only at the Post Falls Library:
 - a. Donated funds – LGIP Fund #1896
 - b. Ziegele Fund – LGIP Fund #1897
 - c. Lillian Henderson fund for support of children's literature – LGIP Fund #2298
- G. Will take such administrative actions of which it is capable to assist the Kootenai-Shoshone Area Library District transition to operate the Post Falls Library if voters approve.

II. Actions the District will do:

- A. Will pay lease as negotiated, but not to exceed \$500 per annum.
- B. Will continue to provide a conveniently located library facility within the corporate limits of the City of Post Falls.
- C. Will notify City at least eighteen (18) months prior to the beginning of any fiscal year if it intends to discontinue use of the Post Falls Library building for public library purposes. District further agrees that if it ceases to use the City library building as a library, it will return ownership and use of the structure to the City at no further charge.
- D. Will maintain availability of a collection and facilities of size comparable to that made available by the City of Post Falls to the community at the time of election/transition.
- E. Will be responsible for all care and operational maintenance of the Post Falls Library building and grounds as it cares for other buildings in the District system.
- F. Will maintain property insurance upon the library building and any materials and equipment transferred to its ownership as a consequence of assuming responsibility for operation of the Post Falls Library. District will also maintain liability insurance in an amount sufficient to meet the liability obligations established by Idaho law.
- G. Will manage relationships with tenants that are complementary to operation of the building as a library.
- H. It is the understanding of the District that the current Post Falls Library Director desires to retire by or before October 1, 2010. The District will offer continued employment for all other current employees of the Post Falls Library, maintaining their current wages and benefits comparable to those which Post Falls currently provides its employees.-District defines comparable as "making affected employees financially whole by increasing salaries if it is determined that Post Falls benefits are superior." Both City and District agree that for year 1 after the completion of consolidation, City will reimburse District for any sick leave liability (in excess of the annual sick leave allocation) incurred by benefits- affected Post Falls Library personnel. District understands that affected, benefited

employees of Post Falls Library will be paid out all of their vacation and join District with no annual leave carryover.

- I. Will become a member of PERSI for all qualifying employees, thereby maintaining the continuity of retirement plans for all former Post Falls Library employees.
- J. It is the intent to allow a Post Falls resident (preferably a member of the current Post Falls Library Board) to be appointed as a member of the District Board as soon as possible, optimally by appointment. Appointment would come only with a resignation from the Kootenai-Shoshone Area Library District Board. If no unscheduled vacancy exists, there can be no appointment.
- K. Will continue to work with Friends of the Post Falls Library and the Post Falls Library Foundation assuring that any monies raised by the Foundation and/or the Friends are utilized for the Post Falls Library location unless these organizations decide to work with KSAL Foundation and Friends groups for opportunities that benefit the entire District.

III. Mutual Recognition of Contingencies

The City and the District recognize that this Agreement Regarding Intent is contingent upon voter approval of incorporating Post Falls into the Kootenai-Shoshone Area Library District. The parties also acknowledge that this Agreement Regarding Intent is intended to provide a principled framework by which future agreements may be shaped, but at the time of its making the parties lack many details that will need to be addressed in final documents. The parties agree to cooperate with one another to resolve any unexpected contingencies that arise in the course of arriving at the terms of any final agreement, recognizing that each party must ultimately fulfill its respective obligations of public responsibility.



Minutes KSAL Special Board Meeting 7-22-09

The Board Meeting was called to order at 9:00 AM by Board Chair Richard Carson.

Additions to agenda:

No additions.

Consolidation Discussion

John attended the Post Falls City Council meeting on Tuesday evening July 21st. He was able to speak to questions that the council had related to consolidation. Two council members asked if the full time City Library employees are satisfied with the District's benefits package. Eric Keck said that the employees felt it was the best thing for the citizens of Post Falls as well as for themselves. Jerry Mason, city attorney, said that the document signed today does not keep future details from being worked out. John addressed the council concern about what would happen if the District decided to give the building back. The City Council voted unanimously to support the Intergovernmental Agreement. The mayor and city clerk signed the agreement. Judy, Glen and Richard explored with John what the options for expansion of the building in Post Falls might be in light of the current agreement.

John said now it is up to the KSAL Board to decide to send the petitions to the City Council. Judy asked if there are any unknown items that might cause problems down the road. Jack said he is sure there are, but that should not deter us from doing what we think is right. John talked about the fact that this is a significant change. The board conducted an in depth discussion of taxing issues related to the consolidation. Katie asked if the City Council said anything about an election campaign. John said they did not and probably would not until we submit the petitions given to us by Post Falls residents.

John said the law states that we need to approve or disapprove the petition to consolidate that was submitted to us at the Spirit Lake meeting in June. John read the petition to the board.

The board approved the petition seeking an election to consolidate the City of Post Falls Library into the Consolidated Free Library District aka the Kootenai-Shoshone Library District as presented to the KSAL Board on June 23, 2009. M, C, Reading

Glen asked that the board consider potential taxpayer concerns about the consolidation. Glen noted that those concerns could be handled by talking about the savings, economy of scale and growth that we expect to see down the road.

Judy asked that staff should do a short white paper that will cover these issues. John said staff would do that. Judy suggested that we title the paper: "Why the Post Falls Consolidation is in our benefit. Richard stated that there are three points that need to be brought forward:

1. It puts library service in the hands of library specialists
2. There will be several economies of scale
3. It erases an arbitrary political line that has had a negative effect on funding

John added a 4th reason:

4. It is revenue neutral

Richard asked if there was a need for another special meeting. John said no. The meeting adjourned at 10:47
