

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-05-066

RESOLUTION DECLARING THE BOUNDARIES AND DISTRICTS OF THE ARROW JUNCTION FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT DULY ORGANIZED PURSUANT TO IDAHO CODE 31-1407 AND 31-1409.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Idaho Code 31-1401, et seq., a petition for formation of a fire protection district to be known as the Arrow Junction Fire Protection District was presented to the Board of County Commissioners, a hearing was held and the boundaries of said district were set according to statute and an election was held to determine whether or not the proposed fire district would be organized; and

WHEREAS, an election was held on May 15, 2012, and the votes cast were canvassed by the Board of County Commissioners and pursuant to Idaho Code 31-1407; and

WHEREAS, the canvassing of the votes show that more than one-half (1/2) of the votes cast were "yes" votes; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Idaho Code 31-1409, the Board of County Commissioners are required to divide the fire protection district into three (3) districts from which the fire district commissioners may be chosen and may qualify for election to office.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED THAT:

Section 1: Pursuant to Idaho Code 31-1407 the Arrow Junction Fire Protection District is hereby declared organized and shall be known as the Arrow Junction Fire Protection District.

Section 2: Pursuant to Idaho Code 31-1407 and 31-1409, the boundaries and districts shall be as shown and described on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein as though fully set forth.

Section 3: This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.



Arrow Junction Fire Protection District Boundaries are as follows:

A Rural Fire District located in Sections 1, 12, 13, 14, 23 & 24, T. 36 N., R., 4 W., B.M. & Sections 6, 7 & 18, T. 36 N. R. 3 W., B.M., Nez Perce County, Idaho; more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the Southwest Corner of said Section 14, which is the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING for this description, running thence along the South line of said Section 14 to the south Quarter Corner of said Section 14;

Thence Northerly along the Meridional Centerline of said Section 14 to the North 1/16 corner on the Meridional Centerline;

Thence Easterly on the North 1/16 line of said Section 14 to the North 1/16 corner common to said Sections 13 & 14;

Thence along the North 1/16 line of said Section 13 to the point of intersection of said 1/16 line and the West 1/16 line of said Section 13;

Thence Northerly along said West 1/16 line to the West 1/16 Corner Common to said Sections 12 & 13;

Thence Easterly along the South line of said Section 12 to the South Quarter Corner of said Section 12;

Thence Northerly along the Meridional Centerline of said Section 12 to the North Quarter Corner of said Section 12;

Thence Northerly along the Meridional Centerline of said Section 1 to the Center Quarter Corner of said Section 1;

Thence Easterly along the Latitudinal Centerline of said Section 1 to the Quarter Corner common to said Sections 1 & 6; said point being on the Range line between Range 3 & 4;

Thence Northerly along said Range line to a point on the Northerly line of Township 36 N., and the Northwest Corner of said Section 6;

Thence Easterly along the North line of said Section 6 to the North Quarter Corner;

Thence Southerly along the Meridional Centerline of said Section 6 to the South Quarter Corner;

Thence Easterly along the South line of said Section 6 to a point on the Centerline of the Clearwater River;

Thence Southwesterly along said Clearwater River Centerline to a point on the West 1/32 line of said Section 7;

Thence Southerly along said 1/32 line to a point on the North line of said Section 18;

Thence Southerly along the West 1/32 line of said Section 18 to a point on the Latitudinal Centerline of said Section 18;

Thence Westerly along said Latitudinal Centerline to the Quarter Corner Common to said Sections 13 & 18, which is on the Range line between Ranges 3 & 4;

Thence Southwesterly along a straight line to the North Quarter Corner of said Section 24;

Thence Southerly along the Merdianal Centerline of said Section 24 to the Center Quarter Corner;

Thence Westerly along the Latitudinal Centerline of said Section 24 to the Quarter Corner Common to said Sections 23 & 24;

Thence continuing along the Latitudinal Centerline of said Section 23 to the West Quarter Corner;

Thence Northerly along the West Line of said Section 23 to the Southwest Corner of said Section 14 and the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.

Said Rural Fire District Contains 2,397.4 acres, more or less.

Commissioner District 1:

Commencing at the Southwest Corner of Section 14 Township 36N Range 4W , which is the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING for this description, running thence along the South line of said Section 14 to the south Quarter Corner of said Section 14;

Thence Northerly along the Meridional Centerline of said Section 14 to the North 1/16 corner on the Meridional Centerline;

Thence Easterly on the North 1/16 line of said Section 14 to the intersection with Catholic Creek;

Thence Southeasterly along Catholic Creek to the center of the Clearwater River;

Thence Southwesterly along the center of the Clearwater River to its intersection with west section line of Section 23 Township 36 North Range 4 West;

Thence, Northerly along the west section line of Section 23 to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.

Commissioner District 2:

Commencing at a Point where the North 1/16 line of Section 14 Township 36 North Range 4 West intersects with Catholic Creek, which is the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING, running thence easterly along the North 1/16 line of said Section 14 to the North 1/16 corner common to said Sections 13 & 14;

Thence along the North 1/16 line of said Section 13 to the point of intersection of said 1/16 line and the West 1/16 line of said Section 13;

Thence Northerly along said West 1/16 line to the West 1/16 Corner Common to said Sections 12 & 13;

Thence Easterly along the South line of said Section 12 to the South Quarter Corner of said Section 12;

Thence Northerly along the Meridional Centerline of said Section 12 to the North Quarter Corner of said Section 12;

Thence Northerly along the Meridional Centerline of said Section 1 to the Center Quarter Corner of said Section 1;

Thence Easterly along the Latitudinal Centerline of said Section 1 to the Quarter Corner common to said Sections 1 & 6; said point being on the Range line between Range 3 & 4;

Thence Northerly along said Range line to a point on the Northerly line of Township 36 N., and the Northwest Corner of said Section 6;

Thence Easterly along the North line of said Section 6 to the intersection with Idaho State Highway 3;

Thence Southerly along the centerline of State Highway 3 to the Intersection with US Highway 12;

Thence Easterly along the centerline of US Highway 12 to the West 1/32 line of Section 7 Township 36 N Range 3 W, being the Arrow Fire District Boundary;

Thence along the Arrow Fire District Boundary, southerly, southwesterly, westerly, northerly to the center of the Clearwater River;

Thence Northeasterly along the center of the Clearwater River to its confluence with Catholic Creek;

Thence Northwesterly along Catholic Creek to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.

Commissioner District 3:

Commencing at a point where the North section line of Section 6 of Township 36 N Range 3 W intersects with State Highway 3, which is the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING, thence Easterly along the North line of said Section 6 to the North Quarter Corner;

Thence Southerly along the Meridional Centerline of said Section 6 to the South Quarter Corner;

Thence Easterly along the South line of said Section 6 to a point on the Centerline of the Clearwater River;

Thence Southwesterly along said Clearwater River Centerline to a point on the West 1/32 line of said Section 7;

Thence Southerly along said 1/32 line to a point intersecting with the centerline US Highway 12;

Thence Westerly along US Highway 12 to the intersection with State Highway 3;

Thence Northerly along State Highway 3 to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.





A fire protection district is proposed for an area located in Nez Perce County, State of Idaho, as shown on the map filed in the County Clerk's office. The name of the district will be "Arrow Junction Fire Protection District".

The purpose of formation of a fire protection district is the protection of property against fire and the preservation of life and is declared by the State of Idaho to be a public benefit, use and purpose.

Upon formation of a district all taxable property within the boundaries of said district shall be assessed equally in proportion to its assessed valuation to defray the cost of equipping and maintaining the district. The maximum tax rate that would be imposed upon taxable property is .0024.




