THIS MATTER came to be heard before the Board of Directors of the Boise Warm Springs Water District at a regularly called and convened meeting the 17th day of January 1979, upon a Petition for Annexation (inclusion) of property to the Boise Warm Springs Water District filed and presented by Joseph Carl and Glenna LaNeice Dille organized under the laws of the State of Idaho, Petitioners and Owners of said property, a copy of which Petition marked Exhibit "A" is attached herein and made a part hereof by reference and attachment, and to a Notice of Hearing, said Petition for Annexation at this time and place published in The Idaho Statesman, a newspaper published in Boise, Idaho, and of general circulation in the District, on the dates of January 22 1979, January 29 1979, and February 5 1979 the proof of which more fully appears in the Affidavit of Publication marked Exhibit "B" being attached hereto and incorporated herein and made a part hereof by incorporation and attachment. No person appeared to protest or object to the annexation (inclusion) of the property owned by the Petitioners.

Upon examining the Petition of Annexation (inclusion) of Property, hearing and examining the Petitioners and examining all proof (documentary and oral) submitted to the Board's consideration, the Board found and concluded that (i) the said Petition of Annexation (inclusion) of Property was in substantial compliance with law and executed by the Petitioners and acknowledged in the manner required by law; (ii) it would be in the best interest of the District and the Property affected to annex and include the property of the Petitioners, subject to all conditions enumerated in the said Petition and as hereinafter specified; (iii) the Notice of Hearing of said Petition was given in the manner required by law; and (iv) there is not good cause to deny the Petition for Annexation.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ORDERED that it would be in the best interest of the Boise Warm Springs Water District of Ada County, Idaho, that the property particularly and specifically described by Exhibit "A", attached hereto and incorporated herein by attachment, be, and the same hereby is, annexed and included within the boundaries of the Boise Warm Springs Water District, subject to all of the (i) limitations and obligations imposed by Sections 42-3218 and 42-3220, Idaho Code; (ii) all conditions enumerated and specified in the Petition for Annexation marked Exhibit "A", incorporated herein and made a part hereof by attachment; and (iii) subject to all conditions specified in the motion for annexation as passed at the Board meeting of February 14th 1979



**A RESOLUTION INCLUDING (ANNEXING) CERTAIN PROPERTY WITHIN THE
BOUNDARY OF THE BOISE WARM SPRINGS WATER DISTRICT OF ADA COUNTY,
IDAHO; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS, pursuant to provision of Section 42-3218, Idaho Code, the boundaries of any
water district may be changed upon application for inclusion of property by the owners
paying fees thereof, meeting conditions imposed and after due and lawful notice of a public
hearing upon said application; and**

**WHEREAS, a Petition for Annexation (inclusion) of property to the Boise Warm Springs
Water District of Ada County, Idaho, was filed and presented by Joseph Carl and Glenna
LaNeice Dille and**

**WHEREAS, at a regularly and duly called and convened meeting held January 17th 1979
the Board of Directors of said district approved and granted Petition of Annexation
(inclusion), subject to all conditions specified in said Petition and subject to the limitations
and obligations imposed by Sections 42-3218 and 42-3220, Idaho Code, the Board
specifically finding that: (i) the Petition for Annexation (inclusion) was in substantial
compliance with law and executed and acknowledged by the true and lawful property
owners in the manner and form by law; (ii) it would be in the best interest of the District and
the properties affected to annex and include the property of the Petitioners; and (iii) notice
of this hearing was given in the manner required by law.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE
BOISE WARM SPRINGS WATER DISTRICT OF ADA COUNTY, IDAHO,**

**Section 1. That the Petition for Annexation (inclusion) to the Boise Warm Springs Water
District submitted by the owners, a copy of which is marked Exhibit "A" being attached
hereto and incorporated herein by attachment and reference, be, and the same hereby is,
approved and granted, and that from and after an Order of Inclusion by the Boise Warm**

Springs Water District, the property described in said Petition be, and the same shall be annexed and included within the boundaries of the Boise Warm Springs Water District, subject to all conditions enumerated and obligations imposed by Sections 42-3218 and 42-3220, Idaho Code.

Section 2. That the Chairman of the Board of Directors and the Secretary be, and that they hereby are, directed to execute and attest an order in the substantial form and content of a proposed Order marked Exhibit "B", being attached hereto and incorporated herein by attachment and reference, to be filed with the Clerk of the District Court for Annexation (inclusion) of the property described in the aforesaid petition.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval hereof.
