

## Itemized Deduction Worksheet for Idaho

Complete lines 1-4 *if you plan to itemize deductions*. If you're married and both work or either of you have multiple jobs, complete this worksheet for the highest-paying job.

1.	<p>Enter the estimated amount of your 2020 itemized deductions.</p> <p>Itemized deductions are: qualifying mortgage interest, charitable contributions, real estate taxes, medical expenses greater than 10% of your income. (See IRS Pub. 505.) <b>Don't</b> include local income taxes or general sales taxes.</p>	
2.	<p>Enter your standard deduction amount for 2020:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● \$24,800 if married filing jointly or qualifying widow(er)</li> <li>● \$18,650 if head of household</li> <li>● \$12,400 if single or married filing separately</li> </ul>	
3.	<p>Subtract line 2 from line 1. If less than zero, enter "0".</p>	
4.	<p>Divide line 3 by \$2,960. Enter only whole numbers (rounding down).</p>	

Add the number on line 4 to the number of Idaho allowances you're claiming on line 1 of the Form ID W-4.
