To qualify as a nontaxable disbursement, the sale of motor fuel must meet all of the following requirements:							
The retail outlet must be located within the boundaries of the federally recognized American Indian reservation.							
<ul> <li>A federally recognized American Indian tribe or an enrolled member of the tribe must own the retail fuel outlet.</li> <li>The member must be an enrolled member of the same tribe on whose reservation the retail outlet is located.</li> </ul>							
<ul> <li>The Idaho licensed fuel distributor must deliver the fuel to the retail outlet located within the boundaries of a federally recognized American Indian reservation.</li> </ul>							
The Idaho licensed fuel distributor must document the sale to show it meets the above requirements.
