However, the smaller the map, the harder it is to see the detail that we may require. This is where map books come in handy. Map books allow us to print maps covering larger areas at our desired scale by breaking the area into individual sheets, which form the pages of a book. In ArcGIS Pro, this functionality is called a Map Series.
