### MSB005 COPY SPOOLED FILE TO TAPE

## **PROGRAM FUNCTION:**

This program provides the user with a method of copying a spooled file to a tape.

#### REQUIRED RESPONSES SUPPLIED BY OPERATOR:

Before going to these prompts, go to your spool file (WRKSPLF), find the report you want to copy to tape, and put an 8 in the option and enter. Take a print screen of this information – it will help you answer prompts #05-09 below:

- 01 Put a tape in the tape drive
- 02 Enter the name of the Tape Device (usually 'TC')
- 03 Do you want to initialize the tape? (Y or N)
- 04 If "Y" to initialize tape, enter volume name (Need to give it a name Max of **6** characters)
- 05 Enter spool file name (File)
- 06 Enter the Job Name of the spooled file (Job)
- 07 Enter the User name of the spooled file (User)
- 08 Enter the Job number of the spooled file (Number)
- 09 Enter the spooled file number (File Nbr)

#### COMMENTS:

When this program is executed, it creates file SPLF01 in Library QGPL. SPLF is subsequently cleared and reloaded each time a spool file is copied to tape.

If you are saving several spool files to the same tape, only initialize the tape the first time through. If you initialize on the 2<sup>nd</sup> pass, it will wipe out your first saved spool file.
