SPECIAL TYPE EDIT

PROGRAM FUNCTION:

This program edits the Special Type file with the Parcel Master file.

REQUIRED RESPONSES SUPPLIED BY OPERATOR:

- 01 Limits
- 02 Printer prompts
- 03 Edit all or select special types? (A or S)
- 04 (If "S") Enter special types (20 max)
- 05 Edit all or select improvement categories? (A or S)
- 06 (If "S") Enter categories (30 max)
- 07 Include, exclude, or process all code areas? (I, E, or A)
- 08 (If "I" or "E") Enter code areas (30 max)
- 09 Include non-applicable special types? (Y or N)
- 10 Print address and legal? (Y or N)

Do you want to edit parcels with: (Y or N)

- 11 At least one improvement category but no special type?
- 12 At least one special type but no improvement category?
- 13 More improvement categories than special types?
- 14 More special types than improvement categories?

COMMENTS:

If code areas are keyed in, they should be in the format 0010000 for code area 1-0000.

OUTPUT SUMMARY (or NA):

The report will list the parcel number, code area, name, whether non-applicable, address, legal, categories, quantities, units, and values (if requested), and the following edits (when applicable):

** Special type equals blank

Parcel has a special type record with no type in it.

** Special units equals zero for special type (X)

No units entered for special type. Number of units times cost/unit will equal zero.

** Special type not in special detail file (UASDTL00)

Parcel has a special type not found in the special detail file. No calculation can be made.

** At least one improvement category but no special type

Parcel has at least one of the improvement categories specified, but none of the special types specified.

** At least one special type but no improvement category

Parcel has at least one of the special types specified, but none of the improvement categories specified.

** More improvement categories than special types

Parcel has more improvement categories than special types.

** More special types than improvement categories

Parcel has more special types than improvement categories.

SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The optional edits (prompts 11, 12, 13, and 14) should be used when keying in special types. These will help insure that special types have been entered on all the appropriate parcels.

The non-optional edits ("Special type equals blank", "Special units equals zero for special type (X)", "Special type not in special detail file UASDTL00") should always be fixed.

When using this program prior to rolling, the program should be run on all special types, and the optional edits need not be selected.
