PP-INVENTORY LIST (STAND ALONE)

PROGRAM FUNCTION:

This program lists inventory items, per parcel, in detail from the Personal Property file.

REQUIRED RESPONSES SUPPLIED BY OPERATOR:

- 01 Limits
- 02 Do you want to list only those parcels
with a current review year? (Y or N)
- 03 If Y - Enter current review year (XXXX)
- 04 Enter "S" for stock paper, "R" for summary sheets.
- 05 Do you want an Alpha, alpha by Zip, or Numeric listing?
(Enter A, Z, or N)
- 06 Do you want 'Report due to Assessor by March 15' to print?
(Y or N)

OUTPUT SUMMARY (or NA):

The report lists the parcel key, code area, name, address, date of listing and the property address, the line, quantity, item, make/model, serial number, owner ID, fuel type, year manufactured, year purchased, cost, schedule number, function code, factor percentage, category number, dollar adjustment, extended market value, total cost, total adjustment and depreciated value per category, as well as total cost, total adjustments, and total depreciated value per parcel. It also states whether it is an alphabetical, numerical or zip listing. If the PP record has an exemption, a line will print displaying the exemption type (Intangible or Post Consumer Waste) and exemption amount.

If a record has a QIE (Qualifying Investment Exemption) record with either the first or second exemption year equal to the current year, the purchase price is zeroed out and an additional line is printed showing: the recapture date, whether the item was new or used, which exempt year is currently being processed, the amount exempt for the current exempt year, and the date placed in service.

If the record has a QIE record that has passed its two exempt years but has not yet reached the recapture date, the purchase price is processed normally and a message is printed notifying the user of the recapture date.

SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

If summary sheets are requested, they will go to the print spool on hold until they are released and the prompts are responded to from the system console.
