Estate Tax Reform - This bill adds the residency requirement to section 63-Idaho State Tax July 1, 2020 Law 701 Idaho Code making Administrative Rule 701 obsolete, which will be Commission HO381 deleted to confirm with the Governor's Red Tape Reduction Act. Sales Tax Distribution - This bill establishes a new base amount for sales tax July 1, 2020 Representative Law Monks distribution by using the previous year's distribution. Additionally, if sales tax collections increase, the first 1% is divided amongst all of the cities. If the HO408 state collects more than a 1% revenue increase than the previous year, the excess funds are only distributed to cities that receive less than their respective counterparts based on a per capita calculation.
